

1.0 General Information About the Agency:

- 1.1 Licking Metropolitan Housing Authority, (LMHA), is a political subdivision of the state of Ohio. There are two entities within LMHA.
- The Public Housing Program, which consists of a 100 unit, elderly designated seven-story apartment building for low to very-low income individuals. Of those units, 99 are rental apartments and one office.
 - The second entity consist of 1089 vouchers from the following programs; 1030 Housing Choice Vouchers, 3 Shelter Plus Care Programs, and VASH Vouchers, (totaling 1089 units).
- 1.2 The Administrative Building is owned by LMHA. Two-thirds of the building consists of offices for the Housing Choice Voucher and Shelter Plus Care Programs. One-third of the building is used for rental space. The Licking County Community Health Clinic occupies this space.
- 1.3 There are 12 employees as follows: Executive Director, Financial Operations Manager, Executive Assistant, Compliance Monitor, HQS Inspector, 2 Occupancy Specialists, Intake Specialist, Part-time Receptionist, Public Housing Manager, 1 full-time and 1 part-time Maintenance Technicians.
- 1.4 LMHA is a host site for student interns and student volunteers from Central Ohio Technical College, and The Ohio State University, Main Campus. Both entitie4s are also host sites for the Vantage Program.

2.0 LMHA Mission Statement:

LMHA improves the quality of life in Licking County, by providing decent, safe, sanitary, and affordable housing to low-to-moderate income families. To accomplish this, LMHA will operate in an efficient manner, within HUD guidelines, and through partnership with the community. LMHA will operate with a high degree of organizational effectiveness in order to remain financially viable.
